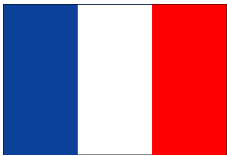

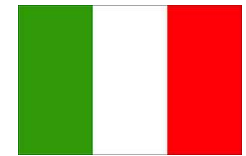
2019 ~ 2020 Destinations...

- ★ France (3 month program)



Elementary School Students may apply for:

- ★ France (3 month program)

International Languages:



Secondary School Students may apply for:

- ✿ Spain (3 month program)
- ✿ Italy (3 month program)
- ✿ Germany (3 month program)

- **To increase awareness of other cultures**
- **To promote personal growth and development**
- **To foster a global perspective**
- **To provide an opportunity to live and study abroad**

CEEF Reciprocal Student Exchange...

Two / Three-month Program



Time Frame:

- Mid-August to early-November:*

(Mid-August to mid-October for the 2 month program)

Exchange Students attend school in Canada

- Early-February to late April:*

(Early-February to early April for the 2 month program)

*Canadian Students attend partner's school
abroad*

CEEF Reciprocal Student Exchange...



Two / Three-month Program

Eligibility:

- **Secondary Students 14 to 17 years of age**
- **Students in Grade 8 during exchange year (France)**
- **Excellent attendance and solid academic performance**
- **Recommendation of Teacher and approval of Principal**



Secondary School Credits during the Exchange Year...

- many participants complete 8 credits during exchange year
- participants should take 3 or 4 courses for credit in Semester 2
- careful planning of program with Student Services is essential
- students going to France, Spain, Italy or Germany, should have some knowledge of the language before leaving for their exchange
- most students sign contractual agreements—COURSE COMPLETION CONTRACTS—with teachers to complete equivalent assignments before departure or during exchange
- students can take courses through Summer School or night school
- some Boards have Internet-based learning opportunities... Students register and take courses on-line (enquire at Student Services)

Two / Three-month Program



Fee and Applications

Fee (if successfully matched): France, Germany, Italy • \$2995
Spain • \$2095

Included:

- Return Travel from Toronto to final destination abroad with escorts on international flights
- Emergency Medical, Cancellation, Interruption and Baggage Insurance

NOT included:

- Travel from home town/city to Toronto Airport and back
- Pocket money (\$300 - \$350 per month recommended)
- Board administrative surcharge if applicable

Family responsibilities:

- Provide opportunities for the visiting student to experience the culture of Canada
- Provide accommodation in your home in a warm and caring environment
- Provide three meals a day as well as transportation to and from school
- Include the visiting student in any family based activities at no extra cost to the visiting student

Applications: • Submit in Fall, Winter, or Early Spring

Summer Cultural Program



Destinations: ❄️ France * ❄️ Spain **

Time Frame: • July/August

* Canadian students go to France in July and host here in August

** Canadian students host here in July go to Spain in August

Eligibility:

- Secondary students may apply for France or Spain
- Elementary students may only apply for France
- Approval of Principal

Fee (if successfully matched): • \$2995

Included:

- Return Travel from Toronto Airport to final destination abroad with escorts on international flights
- Emergency Medical, Cancellation/Interruption and Baggage Insurance

NOT included: • Pocket money (\$300 - \$350 per month recommended)

Family responsibilities:

- Provide opportunities for the visiting student to experience the culture of Canada
- Provide accommodation in your home in a warm and caring environment
- Provide three meals a day
- Include the visiting student in any family based activities at no extra cost to the visiting student



The Application Process...

Preliminary Applications are available from your school or may be downloaded from www.ceef.ca, or by calling the CEEF Office at 705 739-7596, or emailing: info@ceef.ca

- **Complete Preliminary Application**
 - Preliminary Application must be signed by Principal
- **Send Preliminary Application to CEEF Office in Barrie. Upon receipt we will email you the Full Application Package**
 - Include deposit cheque with your Preliminary Application
 - \$400 for Two / Three-month Programs
 - \$400 for Summer Programs
- **Complete Full Application Package**
 - Full Application must also be signed by Principal
- **Send completed Full Application to CEEF Office, with:**
 - required photos
 - copy of most recent Report Card (for two / three month program only)
- **Receive dossier of proposed partner for acceptance**
- **Complete Acceptance Form and send to CEEF Office**

How matching of applicants is done...

- year/grade in school
- boy only/girl only/boy or girl
- allergies
- personality
- interests and hobbies
- extra-curricular activities

- medical conditions
- dietary restrictions
- smoking / non-smoking
